

School-based Training COVID-19 Guidelines

The safety of our team and training participants is our top priority. As such, the Foundation has implemented disinfecting guidelines with the intent of reducing any possible community spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19). **It is imperative that the following guidelines be followed for the presentation to occur. Any variance will cause the presentation to be cancelled and scheduled for a later date.**

FACILITATOR AND PARTICIPANTS MUST WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES DURING THE TRAINING

Participants are to provide their own mask. If the participant's mask is not available, the Foundation will provide a disposable mask for the training.

1. A Safety Kit must be taken to all scheduled trainings. The kit includes gloves, masks, hand sanitizer and disinfectant. If the kit is not present at the training, the training will be cancelled.
2. Foundation team member (Facilitator) providing the training must take their temperature just prior to training regardless if departing from the office or from their home for the training. Temperature must be documented on the Foundation's Health Screening Form.
3. Facilitator to follow school protocol when arriving at school.
4. All participants must apply hand sanitizer when entering the training location.
5. Participants should maintain physical distancing of at least 6 feet while in the location.
6. Facilitator to wear disposable gloves during the hands-on portion of the training.
7. All hands-on materials including manikin(s) and sample rescue-medications are to be disinfected in the training location at the beginning and end of the training. Gloves must be worn during the process.
8. Each participant is to wear gloves for the hands-on portion of the training; this includes the time touching the manikin(s) and sample rescue-medications. Gloves are to be disposed of when finished.
 - If the participant elects not to wear gloves, the participant must apply hand sanitizer before and after touching the manikin.
 - The manikin and sample rescue-medications must be disinfected by the facilitator before and after each participant with no gloves.
9. Facilitator must wipe down hard surface area(s) used for training prior to leaving.
10. The Facilitator reserves the right to cancel or reschedule any training that is deemed unsafe or when these safety procedures cannot be fully implemented.
